

**JOB PROGRESS REPORT

JOB TITLE: Construction of Pumpout Facilities

PERIOD COVERED: October 1, 2000 to May 31, 2001

OBJECTIVE

1. To construct one (1) pumpout facility at each of the following marinas, Gregorio Perez Memorial Marina in Hagatna and Agat Marina in Agat, which will provide recreational boaters with facilities to dispose of their sewage.
2. To develop a boater education program to educate boaters in the proper procedures for using the pumpout facilities and increase environmental awareness of the negative aspects of direct discharge of waste into the ocean.

RESULTS

Contracts were awarded to P. C. Carlos Construction and Bascon Corporation for the construction of the pumpout stations at the Gregorio Perez Memorial Marina and Agat Marina, respectively. Construction on the Agat Marina pumpout station was completed by January 2001. Slight problems were encountered at the Gregorio Perez Memorial Marina. Once these problems were resolved, construction continued and was completed by March 2001.

For the boater education program, flyers were designed to be handed out to the boaters. The Bureau of Planning is working with DAWR to produce an episode of "Man, Land, and Sea" on the importance of pumpout stations. The episode will be produced at the end of October and will air in November.

A memorandum of understanding between DAWR and Port Authority of Guam will be formulated for maintenance and operation of the pumpout stations.

PROGRAM COST: \$500

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
