**SUMMARY**

Translocation of Mariana crows from Rota to Guam remained on hold pending receipt of a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service endangered species permit. Written plans for translocation, artificial incubation, hand rearing, releasing of crows on Guam, and area-wide brown tree snake control were completed and submitted, as requested by the Mariana Crow Recovery Team (Aguon 1998a, 1998b).

**PROGRAM COSTS**

The estimated cost for this project under E-2-1 is \$5,000.
